In today's gospel, Jesus appears to his disciples and shows them his hands and his side; later he invites the doubting Thomas to touch the holes from the nails and the gash from the soldier's lance. We all have scars from our own Good Fridays that remain despite our small experiences of resurrection. Our 'nail holes' remind us that all pain, grief ridicule, suffering, disappointments, and anguish are transformed into healing and peace in the love of God we experience from others and that we extend to them. Jesus tells Thomas and his brothers not to be afraid of the nail marks, the scars, the fractured bones, the crushed spirit, and the broken heart. Compassion, forgiveness, justice - no matter how clumsily offered - can heal and mend.
