This Sunday's Gospel is the account of our Lord's first miracle – the turning the water into wine. Try and imagine that you are present at the wedding feast at Cana. You may choose to be a guest, a disciple or one of the servants. Use all your senses to bring the feast alive in your mind.

What do you see, hear, smell, touch, and taste? What do you feel as you take part in the celebrations?

When Mary turns towards her son, asking him to help at the feast, what do you notice about their relationship?

As you see what happens next, what is your reaction to witnessing this miracle, or 'sign'?

Ask Jesus to explain the deeper meaning of his actions at the feast.

Read the passage slowly, once more.

This time, when Mary says, "Do whatever he tells you", imagine she speaks these words to you, in the midst of your life.

What is Jesus asking you to do? How do you respond?

Response to the Psalm:

Proclaim the wonders of the Lord among all the peoples.

Gospel Acclamation:

Alleluia!

Through the Good News God called us to share the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.
