On this feast of the saints Peter and Paul we might step back to consider our own response to Christ's call. Peter's confession of Jesus as the Messiah, Son of the Living God, became the cornerstone of the church. Paul's response on the road to Damascus turned him from a persecutor to a disciple, and ultimately, apostle to the Gentiles. Each died to a past way of life and opened themselves to new possibilities by their faith in Christ. Peter overcame his denial of Jesus and Paul overcame his persecution, but both did so only with the Grace of God. Though neither could likely foresee their eventual martyrdom in Rome, the capital of the empire, each pursued what they knew to be true to the end. May we like St Peter and St Paul find the grace to pursue our own path of discipleship, remaining true to the end, no matter where that might lead.
