When Jesus was in the house of the Pharisee who had invited Him to eat, He observes how those invited try to get the first places. It is a very common attitude in life, not only when one is at table: each one tries also to get the first place regarding attention and consideration on the part of others. Everyone, beginning with ourselves, has this experience. But let us pay attention: the words of Jesus which exhort to abstain from seeking the first place are not simply an example of good education; they are a rule of life. Jesus clarifies that it is the Lord who gives to each one dignity and honor. We are not the ones to give it to ourselves, perhaps claiming our own merits. As He did in the Beatitudes, Jesus overturns the judgment and the behavior of this world. The one who recognizes himself a sinner and humble is raised up by God, but the one who instead intends to get recognition and the first place risks excluding himself from the banquet.
