

Welcome: If you are a visitor to the parish, we want you to know how welcome you are – whether you have come from another part of the country, from across the world or simply from another parish.—*welcome*!

The Introit for Gaudete Sunday is taken from Philippians 4:4,5: "Gaudete in Domino semper" ("Rejoice in the Lord always"). Like Lent, Advent is a penitential season, so the priest normally wears purple vestments. But today, on Gaudete Sunday, having passed the midpoint of Advent, the Church lightens the mood a little, and the clergy wear rose vestments. The change in colour provides us with encouragement to continue our spiritual preparation—especially prayer and fasting for Christmas. For this same reason, the third candle of the Advent wreath, lit on Gaudete Sunday, is traditionally rose coloured.

Advent Confessions: The best present that we can give to ourselves this Advent in preparation for Christmas is to make use of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Confessions are available 4 time a week in the parish *(please see timetable on back page of newsletter)*, and upon request from either Fr Nicholas or Fr Kevin.
